TOWNSHIP MANAGER ORDER 1-2020

On April 14, 2020, the Township Council of the Township of Galloway (the "Township") adopted Resolution #104-20 which authorized me to take any and all actions necessary to protect the residents of the Township, in accordance with Administrative Order No. 2020-8 (the "Administrative Order"), as issued by New Jersey's Department of Law and Public Safety, Office of Emergency Management.


The Order was based on Executive Order 108, as issued by Governor Phil Murphy, which specifically stated that it "may be beneficial for localities to be able to impose additional restrictions, and specifically identified that certain municipalities may have legitimate concerns about an influx of new visitors, which may cause public health concerns as the State imposes social distancing measures and aims to avoid unnecessary increases in density of individuals." To clarify Executive Order 108, the Administrative Order was issued and states that Executive Order 108 is amended "to allow municipalities and counties to impose additional restrictions in response to COVID-19 on the ability of hotels, motels, guest houses, or private residences, or parts thereof, to accept new transient guests or seasonal tenants."

In order to best protect the health and safety of the residents of the Township of Galloway, I am hereby exercising the authority granted to me by Township Council and I am making the following order:

Effective at midnight on April 17, 2020, any hotel, motel, or guest house within the Township of Galloway is prohibited from housing any and all guests except for the following groups:

- 1) Guests who are able to prove that they are essential employees with appropriate documentation;
- 2) Guests who are first-responders;
- 3) Guests who are permanent residents of the establishment as defined by the Code of the Township of Galloway; and
- 4) Guests who are able to prove that they are residents of the Township of Galloway who are staying at the establishment in order to self-quarantine.

This order shall remain in effect until I determine that it is no longer necessary. I reserve the right to amend this order as deemed necessary and I, or my staff, reserve the right to inspect any property subject to this order to ensure proper compliance. Violators of this order shall be subject to the "General Penalty Provisions" of the Code of the Township of Galloway.
